

ACES 3rd Annual Scavenger Hunt

It's that time! Time for the 3rd Annual Scavenger Hunt, **September 1 through November 30, 2009**, use your imagination and your creative side to capture images for the six themes of this year's hunt. You may enter all of the theme categories or as few as just one theme. A maximum of two images per category may be submitted. Images you submit must be captured between the above dates, and the image files must have EXIF data attached. If you don't know what I am talking about when I say EXIF data, don't worry about it. You may crop your images and make minor adjustments for sharpening, saturation and exposure. No post production filters or effects may be applied, but filters may be used when shooting an image. for example, neutral density filter, polarizing filter. However, images that appear obviously manipulated in post processing will be disqualified.

Here are this year's theme categories:

Shadows

Patterns

The Color Blue

Water

People At Work

Transportation

Remember, be creative and use your imagination. Images will be judged heavily on creativity and how well they represent the theme. Images will be judged by members of other camera clubs. All submitted images will be shown at our Annual Christmas Party, and a winner will be announced for each theme category. In addition, there will be one image picked as "Best of Show."

Size and prepare your images just as you do for competition.
